

## Privacy Notice for Participants of the VET Marketplace Project

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR), we hereby inform you that:

1. Your personal data will be processed for the purposes of implementing the VET Marketplace Project (Grant Agreement No. 2024-1-PL01-KA220-VET-000257317), co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme, including in particular:
  - o participation in project activities,
  - o use of the VET Marketplace and e-learning platforms,
  - o participation in training courses, webinars, mentoring activities and project-based learning initiatives,
  - o implementation of educational and Work-Based Learning (WBL) activities,
  - o project monitoring, evaluation, reporting and financial accountability,
  - o documenting project results and confirming participants' involvement in project activities.
2. The legal basis for the processing of personal data is Article 6(1)(e) and (f) GDPR (performance of a task carried out in the public interest and the legitimate interests of the Controller related to the implementation of the Erasmus+ project) and, where applicable, Article 6(1)(a) GDPR (consent of the data subject).
3. Recipients of personal data may include project partners, the Foundation for the Development of the Education System (FRSE) – National Agency of the Erasmus+ Programme, the European Commission, IT and hosting service providers, and other entities authorised under applicable law.
4. Personal data may be disclosed to European Union institutions and bodies authorised to monitor, audit, evaluate or control projects financed under the Erasmus+ Programme, in accordance with applicable legal provisions.
5. Personal data will be stored for the duration of the project and for the period required by regulations concerning the archiving, monitoring and auditing of European Union funded projects.
6. Data subjects have the right to access their personal data, rectify inaccurate data, request erasure, restrict processing, request data portability, object to processing and, where processing is based on consent, withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing carried out before such withdrawal.
7. Data subjects have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority responsible for data protection matters.
8. Providing personal data is voluntary; however, it is necessary for participation in the VET Marketplace Project and for the use of its services, tools and platforms.
